11: The modular Bookstack shelving system can be stacked in up to four levels.

12: 4: Panels of honeycomb are stood on their edges and sandwiched between lacquered side panels to create the Wandie chaise-lounges. Felt strips provide additional comfort.

13: Sheets of laminated board provide durable sitting surfaces on the Multichair.

15: The stoic Streep bench is made in a range of lengths, with layers of honeycomb spanning bridge-like between two pillars.

16: Flat elements are joined together to create the easy-to-assemble Eatable, which is produced in two sizes.



The Standing range of furniture designed by A4Adesign explores the potential of recycled honeycomb cardboard as a construction material. A4Adesign has used this single material in a variety of manners - in sheet form (stacked both horizontally and vertically), in block form, cantilevered, sandwiched, and slotted together. The various means of use yield equally numerous expressions of the material's characteristics, but each conveys the strength and lightness of honeycomb cardboard. The versatile Multichair, for example, is a composition of stratified sheets of multiple thicknesses. It features a cantilevered ledge that can function as a reclining surface, a coffee table, or a second seat. Laminated board provides durable sitting surfaces.
